1 Week memberships can be arranged for \$25.


Zip Pay is available so you can reduce the repayment to \$10 a week

Once you pay registration you will receive your training shirt, playing shorts and socks.



HOW TO REGISTER 2020

1. Download the Rugby Xplorer app onto your phone
2. Click the button "More" on bottom right of home page
3. Select "Register"



4. Login or create a Rugby account and press continue
5. Enter "CSU" and press search, select CSU Reddies RUF



6. Under Registration Type, select role as "Player". Registration Type select either "XV's" for men players or "10s Women's" for women players, select Duration as "Season"
7. Complete Personal details, skip the Headshot, complete Additional details and Emergency Contact page.
8. Registration Summary will appear, press continue
9. Payment Details. **Important!** You can pay the whole amount by debit/credit card or select Zip Pay to pay by instalments. Please note that Zip Pay is a completely separate organisation to Rugby AU and once you confirm there is no opportunity for refunds.
10. If you are a CSU student please let us know and we will get the details we require to give to the University.
